Day 1 - visit to the Gura Râului dam and the Water Epuration station in Sibiu - water resources, the importance of water in our lives; (brainstorming - possible solutions to keep water resources clean); creating a poster with a logo promoting water purity (competition)

Day 2 - a trip to the Făgăraș National Park (waterfall and Bâlea Lake), a protected wildlife reserve and a visit to a trout farm - making students aware of the importance of natural resources (air, water, soil, fauna, flora). Students work in mixed groups (1 student from each country in each group) during the workshop: they discuss the impact of tourism on the Transfăgărășan Road and its surroundings on air, water, soil and local biodiversity, and look for possible solutions to conserve the resources of this place; visit to a trout farm - organic gardening; trout dishes / traditional Romanian dishes; competition (quiz) on information obtained during the day.

Day 3 - tree planting campaign; importance of soil and soil diversity; workshops - preparation of a presentation on flora specific for a given country (e.g. oral presentation, video, Power Point presentation, drawing, photo exhibition etc.)

Day 4 - a trip to the Turda salt mine and the gorges of Turzia (this wild reserve is home to over 1000 species of plants and animals, offering a fairy-tale scenery with a rich flora and fauna, waterfalls and caves); obtaining information on salt resources; brainstorming on the use of salt in gastronomy and various therapies (spidergrams); photos, identification of insect and plant species in the area; searching for information about them; creating a description of each of them - an exhibition.

Day 5 - eco- kitchen in the Oaşa monastery; getting to know Romanian (monastic) heritage and healthy eating; the use of mountain plants in the nutrition and treatment of various diseases; participation in culinary classes - showing the cultural aspects of each country involved (preparing, under the supervision of teachers, traditional dishes from their countries using water, salt, spices and other natural resources); posting recipes on the blog; eTwinning chat and forum with students from other countries; de Bono Hats filling, certificates.
