### REPORT ON PROJECTS

Since 2017, the School Projects and Educational Programme Commission has been set up at the school level, whose purpose was to initiate, coordinate, organize and carry out projects that include activities on the main problems faced by students in general. Another purpose was also to involve those students in these activities, belonging to vulnerable groups.

Therefore, activities and projects on the following categories were proposed and carried out:

- Ecological education
- Education for health
- Combating and preventing violence of any kind
- Preventing absenteeism
- Training for the labor market integration and career guidance
- Volunteering with and for the involvement of students belonging to the disadvantaged categories
- prevention of human trafficking/ juvenile delinquency
- sex education
- anti-drug education etc.

The main purpose was the personal development of students, the formation of a beautiful character, the education of students in these fields so that they may be equipped for life, to face various problems in the environment from which they come, to coexist and in the environment in which they enter various situations.
