Analysing the data from the table above we can conclude that:

- ❖ From the total of 21346 absences, 5147 are absences without permission (24,11%) distributed per level as follows:
 - ✚ 9th graders accumulated a number of 3492 absences of which 765 (21,91%) are without permission;
 - ✚ 10th graders accumulated a number of 5063 absences of which 1504 (29,71%) are without permission;
 - ✚ 11th graders accumulated a number of 6252 absences of which 1796 (28,73%) are without permission;
 - ✚ 12th graders accumulated a number of 6539 absences of which 1082 (16,55%) are without permission;
- ❖ From the total of 21346 absences, 12199 are absences accumulated by girls (57,15%);
- ❖ Absences accumulated:
 - ✚ under 200: 3 classes;
 - ✚ between 200 – 500: 5 classes;
 - ✚ between 500 – 750: 12 classes;
 - ✚ between 750 – 1000: 2 classes;
 - ✚ between 1000 – 1500: 7 classes;
 - ✚ above 1500: 1 class.
- ❖ 10450 absences (48,96%) from the total of absences accumulated by the 8 classes which had more than 1000 absences/ 1st semester;
- ❖ 8 classes out of 30 classes (26,67%) accumulated less than 500 absences during the 1st semester;
- ❖ The lowest frequency regarding class attendance is 86,35% (11G);
- ❖ Only 4 classes out of 30 had a frequency of class attendance between 85% - 90%;
- ❖ 15 classes out of 30 had a frequency above 95%;
- ❖ Only 3 classes accumulated less than 200 absences.

Analysing the data from the table above we can conclude that:

- ❖ From the total of 17564 absences, 3193 are absences without permission (18,18%) distributed per level as follows:
 - ✚ 9th graders accumulated a number of 3466 absences of which 492 (14,20%) are without permission; most of the absences are accumulated by the students from the dual system: 9th DA – 1013 of which 156 without permission; 9th DC – 682 of which 102 without permission; 9th G- 520 of which 205 without permission/**39,42%**);
 - ✚ 10th graders accumulated a number of 3905 absences of which 752 (19,26%) are without permission; most absences were accumulated by 10 E 703 of which 182 without permission/ **25,89%**; 10 DC- 451 of which 155 without permission/**34,37%**;

- ✚ 11th graders accumulated a number of 5040 absences of which 1336 (26,51%) are without permission; most absences were accumulated by 11 G- 1103 of which 71 without permission; 11 H- 743 of which 450 without permission/60,57%; 11 DC- 625 of which 462 without permission/73,92%;
- ✚ 12th graders accumulated a number of 5153 absences of which 613 (11,90%) are without permission; most absences were accumulated by 12 G- 1269 of which 203 without permission/ 16%; 12 A- 1021 of which 121 without permission;
- ❖ From the total of 17564 absences, 10147 are absences accumulated by girls (57,77%);
- ❖ Absences accumulated:
 - ✚ under 200: 2 classes (9th grade A, B);
 - ✚ between 200 – 500: 11 classes;
 - ✚ between 500 – 800: 11 classes;
 - ✚ between 800 – 1000: 2 classes;
 - ✚ between 1000 – 1300: 4 classes;
- ❖ 24 classes out of 30 classes (80%) accumulated less than 800 absences during the 2nd semester;
- ❖ The lowest frequency regarding class attendance is 90,96% (11G);
- ❖ Only 5 classes out of 30 (16,67%) had a frequency of class attendance between 90% and 95%;
- ❖ 25 classes (high-school classes) out of 30 (83,33%) had a frequency above 95%.
- ❖ 2 classes (9th grade) out of 30 (6.67%) had a frequency above 99%.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS 2nd semester vs. 1st semester

Throughout the 2nd semester there was a higher percent of students who promoted the class than in the 1st semester by 10,92% (88,15% - 1st semester; 97,78% - 2nd semester) and it is noticeable an increase by 216,46% in the number of students with averages between 9 and 10 (from 79 students in the 1st semester to 250 students in the 2nd semester).

As far as attendance is concerned, there was a considerable decrease in the number of absences. The situation can be presented in the following terms:

- ★ Total number of absences (motivated and unauthorized):
 - ❖ 10th grade – decreased number of absences from 5063 to 3905 by 22,87%;
 - ❖ 11th grade – decreased number of absences from 6252 to 5040 by 19,39%;
 - ❖ 12th grade – decreased number of absences from 6539 to 5153 by 21,20%;

Total per classes (9th-12th grades) - decreased number of absences from 21346 to 17564 by 17,72%.

- ★ Per unauthorized absences (the number decreased):
 - ❖ 9th grade– decreased number of absences from 765 to 492 by **35,69%**;
 - ❖ 10th grade – decreased number of absences from 1504 to 752 by **50%**;
 - ❖ 11th grade – decreased number of absences from 1796 to 1336 by 25,61%;
 - ❖ 12th grade – decreased number of absences from 1082 to 613 by 29,92%;

Total per classes (9th-12th grades)- decreased number of absences from 5147 to 3193 by **37,96%**.

NOTE: This decrease in the number of absences is due to the fact that courses were suspended from the 11th March 2020 because of the pandemic of Corona virus.

Analysing the data from the table above we can conclude that:

- ❖ From the total of 38913 absences, 8423 are absences without permission (21,65%) distributed per level as follows:
 - ✚ 9th graders accumulated a number of 6875 absences of which 1252 (18,21%) are without permission;
 - ✚ 10th graders accumulated a number of 14913 absences of which 2254 (25,10%) are without permission;
 - ✚ 11th graders accumulated a number of 11364 absences of which 3222 (28,35%) are without permission;

✚ 12th graders accumulated a number of 11692 absences of which 1695 (14,50%) are without permission;

- ❖ From the total of 38913 absences, 22366 are absences accumulated by girls (57,48%);
- ❖ Absences accumulated:
 - ✚ under 400: 2 classes (9th A,B);
 - ✚ between 400 – 1000: 6 classes;
 - ✚ between 1000 – 1500: 12 classes;
 - ✚ between 1500 – 2000: 6 classes;
 - ✚ between 2000 – 2500: 3 classes;
 - ✚ between 2500 – 3000: 1 class;
- ❖ 33912 absences (87,15%) from the total of absences accumulated by the 22 classes which had more than 8000 absences/ school year;
- ❖ 8 classes out of 30 classes (26,67%) accumulated less than 1000 absences during the school year, that is 5001 absences (12,85%) out of the total of 38913 absences
- ❖ The lowest frequency regarding class attendance is 88,87% (12th G);
- ❖ 10 classes out of 30 (33,33%) had a frequency of class attendance between 88% and 95%;
- ❖ 20 classes out of 30 (66,67%) had a frequency above 95% (9th grade: 7 classes; 10th grade: 7 classes; 11th grade: 5 classes and 12th grade: 1 class (12th F));
- ❖ Only 1 class had a class attendance of 99% (9th B).
