It is called Miroir d'Eau, because the architecture of the area is reflected in it.



- Then we went to the Primatial Cathedral of St Andrew of Bordeaux, where this great organ is located inside.





- After visiting the city, we eventually took some photos of us and we went straight to Monbazillac, where the highschool was. We got there by 2 buses and we got a very nice, warm and friendly welcoming from students and teachers.

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
